## 7th Grade iPad Rules

- 1. They are to be used for **academic** purposes **ONLY**.
- 2. Unless we are using them, iPads are to remain in the designated area that your teacher has chosen.
  - \* If I say to have them out, they may be on your desk "Apples Up."
- 3. You are not to touch ANY iPad that is not yours unless given permission by a teacher.
- 4. When using the iPads, your volume should be turned off unless otherwise directed by the teacher. Please use appropriate volume when using your earbuds. Headphones should only be worn when directed by a teacher.
- 5. No headphones should be worn on your body in the hallway.
- 6. When using your iPad, you must be on the correct site, app, etc., or you will be considered off task and will receive consequences accordingly.
- 7. The camera is not to be used for any reason unless given explicit permission or direction by the teacher.
- 8. YOU are responsible for maintaining YOUR iPad; this includes keeping it clean and arriving with your iPad fully charged. Therefore, it is your responsibility to take it to and from class. If you leave your iPad anywhere, you are responsible for anything that happens to it.
- 9. When using the iPad, you are to follow all school and 7<sup>th</sup> grade rules and expectations. Any expectations or rules broken will result in consequences and may result in the loss of your iPad.
- 10. Your lock screen should be your student ID card.
